Interview Transcript

Interview with **Nadia** (ESP Lecturer)

Interviewer: Okay, alright, as the teaching preparation, can you tell me what you usually do when coming to class, especially for today's class?

L: There is one book actually that can be used. It is written by one of our lecturers here, but we are also provided with some other sources so we can actually adjust, we can switch the topic. What I usually do is I will see the class condition is. If the class is just right, I mean they are not too high achieving, I will use the module provided by the institution or study program, but we also have some other sources, if the class condition is above the average, then I will combine the other sources. So, I don't stick to one resource only, to one book only, I usually pick the topic from here and there just like what happened in this class. The topic is making telephone calls. The topic itself is contained in our official study program book. I just use the topic but I didn't use the material from there. I collect the materials from other sources.

Interviewer: Alright, so, modify the materials. Okay, about the sources, what kind of sources do you usually use? Online or offline printed sources?

L: Mostly online

Interviewer: Can you mention some resources?

L: What I do is just pick the topic from the lesson plan or from the official lesson plan and then I will collect the resources here and there. I don't stick to one website only, but for speaking I use Mariam Webster Dictionary a lot for pronunciation and for example. For sentence example, Mariam Webster and then Oxford Dictionary, but mainly I use Mariam Webster and for the students, it's up to them to use any dictionary they want as long as the dictionary is from a reputable publisher and it's a monolingual dictionary. That's when I need to check pronunciation, to teach pronunciation and sentence example and also use a lot of YouTube to show them real life situation

Interviewer: So, you play Youtube right?

L: Yes, I play it in front of the class
